We will be touring The Port of Portland headquarters' building designed by Zimmer Gunsul Frasca Architects (ZGF) with our legislators. The Port of Portland headquarters is a LEED gold office that unifies the entity responsible for Portland's airport, shipping terminals and more. The project was finished in May of 2010 and it includes a green roof, a living machine to process waste water, geothermal heating and cooling, plus a plethora of other sustainable strategies.
